- 2. Schedule of LKG Std. II Examination will be fixed by Head of the concerned schools / AROs / DRO of respective Zone.
- 3. The students should come to the school only on those days on which their examination is to be held.
- 4. There will be **no re-examination** in the event of **ABSENCE** on account of any reason including MEDICAL. So, if the students miss any examination he / she will lose the marks of the exam.
- 5. Class attendance of 75% is a must for promotion.
- 6. Schedule of oral examination, Practical examination, Computer/ICT, Drawing of concerned classes / subjects should be prepared by the Principal of the school.
- 7. Question Papers of LKG to Std. II (70 Marks), as well as G.K. and Naitik Shiksha from Std. I to Std. VII will be of 35 marks and should be prepared at school level.
- 8. Weightage of Marks: (i) 30% from Mid Term syllabus and 70% from Annual syllabus (upto Std. VII).
